AIM

To explore the realities of women's work in the informal economy, highlighting their contributions, challenges, and agency. The programme seeks to deepen understanding of the gendered dimensions of labour informality and strengthen participants' capacity to engage with labour governance frameworks, social protection measures, and collective strategies that promote decent, equitable, and inclusive work for women.

OBJECTIVES

- To develop a critical understanding of the informal economy and women's position within changing labour markets.
- To examine labour policies, social protection measures, welfare schemes, and legal provisions relevant to women informal workers, and assess their accessibility and effectiveness.
- To identify structural barriers to women's rights, decent work, and economic security in the informal economy, and explore institutional and collective responses.
- To strengthen participants' capacities in leadership, advocacy, and stakeholder engagement for promoting gender-responsive labour governance.

COURSE PROFILE

The training will introduce key concepts and contemporary debates on informality, labour markets, and decent work, with a focus on women workers. It will examine the changing nature of informal employment, the intersection of gender and labour precarity, and the diverse experiences of women workers across sectors. The course will discuss labour governance frameworks, including labour codes, social security provisions, welfare schemes, and policy initiatives aimed at improving working conditions and livelihood security. Particular attention will be given to challenges related to access to rights, entitlements, social protection, and public services. The programme will also explore the role of worker organisations, trade unions, self-help groups, cooperatives, and other collective platforms in advancing women's labour rights and voice. Through discussions on leadership, advocacy, and policy engagement, participants will reflect on pathways for strengthening inclusive labour governance and promoting decent work outcomes for women in the informal economy.

METHODOLOGY

Lectures and interactive expert talks, Case studies, Reflections through group activity and discussions

PARTICIPATION

Government Officials, Representatives from Central and State Trade Unions, Women Leaders, Civil Society Professionals, and Researchers Working on Gender and Labour.

FACULTY

Faculty from VVGNI and invited experts from academia, government, trade unions, and civil society organisations.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Participants should be above 18 years and below 60 years of age;
2. Should have working knowledge of either Hindi or English.

NOTE:

1. Please note that those who have already attended institute's earlier programme may not apply again. If so, they shall be immediately sent back and no travel allowance will be reimbursed.
2. Children, spouse and family members are not allowed to stay in the Institute's hostel.
3. Participants are requested to book their return journey ticket in advance from their own place.

FEES & TRAVELLING REIMBURSEMENT

There is no programme fee.

1. The institute will reimburse travel expenses by bank transfer; for participants who have an Aadhaar number and a bank account. It's important for nominees to bring their bank details (bank name, branch, IFSC code, and account number) to fill up the TA form. **Participants must attach the original ticket for the inward and outward journey. Without proper tickets, no claims will be re-imbursed.**
2. The institute will reimburse 2nd class sleeper (Non-AC) train or bus fare (Non-AC) from their place to VVG NLI (NOIDA) and back. Local conveyance at the maximum of ₹350 for (Delhi & NCR) and ₹500 (for other states except North East States).
3. For participants from the North Eastern States, the Institute will reimburse 3-tier AC train fare and local conveyance, subject to a maximum limit of ₹750. **In case a participant does not possess a 3-tier (AC) return ticket, reimbursement will be made for II sleeper class fare only, however the difference of 3-tier (AC) train fare shall be paid only upon submission 3-tier (AC) return ticket.**
4. Officials entitled for higher class may claim their Travelling Allowance from their own organisation.
5. For extended stay or early arrival, lodging & boarding charges would be borne by the participants.
