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AIM

The world of work is undergoing unprecedented transformation due to technological advancements, digitalization, artificial intelligence (AI), platform-based employment, demographic shifts, climate change, globalization, changing employment relationships, and evolving worker aspirations. These transformations present opportunities for increased productivity and innovation while simultaneously posing significant challenges related to job displacement, informality, income insecurity, skills mismatch, labour rights, and widening inequalities. This capacity-building programme aims to equip participants with practical knowledge and policy tools to design, implement, and monitor labour market and social protection policies that are inclusive, gender-responsive, and future-ready.

OBJECTIVES

The programme aims to enable participants to:

1. Understand the emerging trends shaping the future of work and assess their implications for employment, labour rights, and decent work in India.
2. Strengthen knowledge and practical skills for implementing labour laws and extending inclusive, gender-responsive, and universal social protection to all workers, particularly those in the informal, gig, platform, and migrant workforce.
3. Enhance institutional capacity to design, implement, monitor, and evaluate evidence-based labour market and social protection policies using digital tools, labour market data, and effective governance mechanisms.
4. Promote social dialogue and collaborative action among government, trade unions, employers, and other stakeholders to address emerging labour market challenges and strengthen worker protection.
5. Develop practical strategies and action plans to advance decent work, improve labour market resilience, and support a just and inclusive transition in the changing world of work.

COURSE PROFILE

- Focus on emerging labour market challenges and the future of work.
- Coverage of decent work, labour rights, social protection, and labour governance.
- Special focus on vulnerable workers, including informal, migrant, women, construction, and gig/platform workers.
- Interactive pedagogy through case studies, group work, policy simulations, and action planning.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Participants should be above 22 years and below 60 years of age;
2. Should have working knowledge of Hindi/ English

NOTE:

1. Please note that those who have already attended institute's earlier programme may not apply again. If so, they shall be immediately sent back and no travel allowance will be reimbursed.
2. Children, spouse and family members are not allowed to stay in the Institute's hostel.
3. Participants are requested to book their return journey ticket in advance from their own place.

FEES & TRAVELLING REIMBURSEMENT

There is no programme fee.

1. The institute will reimburse travel expenses by bank transfer; for participants who have an Aadhaar number and a bank account. It's important for nominees to bring their bank details (bank name, branch, IFSC code, and account number) to fill up the TA form. **Participants must attach the original ticket for the inward and outward journey. Without proper tickets, no claims will be re-imbursed.**
2. The institute will reimburse 2nd class sleeper (Non-AC) train or bus fare (Non-AC) from their place to VVGNI (NOIDA) and back. Local conveyance at the maximum of ₹350 for (Delhi & NCR) and ₹500 (for other states except North East States).
3. For participants from the North Eastern States, the Institute will reimburse 3-tier AC train fare and local conveyance, subject to a maximum limit of ₹750. **In case a participant does not possess a 3-tier (AC) return ticket, reimbursement will be made for II sleeper class fare only, however the difference of 3-tier (AC) train fare shall be paid only upon submission 3-tier (AC) return ticket.**
4. Officials entitled for higher class may claim their Travelling Allowance from their own organisation.
5. For extended stay or early arrival, lodging & boarding charges would be borne by the participants.
