JAL Shakti Ministry's Additional Secretary G Ashok Kumar, who earlier served as Nizamabad Dis-trict Collector, recalled that Vel-lore mandal was declared as the first mandal to completely erad-icate child labor in the country in 2001. This was possible only with the government encouragement, commitment of the authorities, VDCs and the cooperation of people's representatives, he added. A programme was organised at

A programme was organised at Pragati Bhavan Conference Hall here on Friday as part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav', the govern-ment's initiative to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of pro-gressive India and its glorious history, people, culture and achievements, Ashok Kumar fe-licitated local body representa-tives and officials of the district administration, who served in Velpur zone in 2001. Ashok Kumar said that 539 child laborers from Velpur man-dal were admitted to schools at

Stating that children below 15 years should be enrolled in school and not to put to work, he said the country's develop-ment depends on the future of the children and children are im-portant to the country. Stating that Chief Minister K Chan-drashekar Rao is also focusing on education, he said opening of res-idential schools across the State on the same day was a testament to KCR's commitment. It's a good
