82. TELEGRAM TO GOVERNOR-GENERAL

Johannesburg, June 16, 1913

HIS EXCELLENCY LORD GLADSTONE [GOVERNOR-GENERAL PRETORIA]

PASSAGE VIEW **IMMIGRATION** PARLIAMENT, AS-BILL SOCIATION WOULD RESPECTFULLY DRAW YOUR **EXCELLENCY'S** ATTENTION TO FOLLOWING **OBJECTIONS** BILL FROM STAND-BILL FAILS POINT INDIAN COMMUNITY. TO CARRY OUT THE SETTLEMENT IN THAT CONTRARY **PROVISIONAL** TO THAT TAKES AWAY SETTLEMENT IT EXISTING RIGHTS. IT RESTRICTS SUPREME COURT PRESENTLY EXISTING. RIGHT APPEAL IT **DEPRIVES INDIANS** RESIDENT NATAL OF FACILITY PRESENTLY THAT **PROVINCE** AFTER **ABSENCE** ENJOYED, REENTER ON YEARS' STRENGTH THREE **PREVIOUS** RESIDENCE, WHILE £,3 INDENTURED INDIANS WHO HAVE **PAID** TAX MAY NOT BE CLAIM RIGHT UNDER BILL **ALLOWED** RESIDENCE THAT IT TAKES AWAY RIGHT SOUTH PROVINCE AFRICA-BORN CAPE INDIANS ENTER UNDER ITS EXISTING STATUTE. FREE STATE DIFFICULTY REMAINS AS BEFORE IN THAT DECLARATION FROM EDUCATED INDIAN IMMIGRANT WHICH WOULD REQUIRED OTHER NOT BE **REQUIRED** FROM ANY **IMMIGRANT** AS IMMI-THEREFORE ASSOCIATION **EARNESTLY** GRANT. MY PRAYS YOUR EXCELLENCY TO WITHHOLD SANCTION BILL, SO OBVIATE AND PAINFUL STRUGGLE WITH RECURRENCE ALL ITS HARDSHIPS, SACRIFICE FOR COMMUNITY REPRESENTED SUFFERING, AND ASSOCIATION.1 MY
