OBJECTIVES

- To understand new forms of bonded labour and ways to tackle it
- To impart knowledge on Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for Identification and Rescue of Child Labour, Bonded Labour and Prosecution of Offender
- To understand the linkage between human trafficking and bonded labour
- To discuss the importance of effective and timely rehabilitation during the Critical Crisis Period after a bonded labour is rescued
- To understand the role of Statutory and Law Enforcement bodies from identification to immediate rehabilitation
